
GUEST INFORMATION 2023

Ku-ring-gai Lodge is a private ski lodge for members & their accompanied friends.

The Lodge is situated in the Perisher Valley within the Kosciuszko National Park at an altitude of 1,750 m.

In Summer vehicles may be driven right to the Lodge. In Winter only day parking is permitted in Perisher, cars cannot be left overnight. The most convenient Winter access is via the Skitube railway, which has overnight & weekly parking. The Skitube Terminal is on the Alpine Way on the road to Thredbo. Oversnow transport is available to the Lodge from the Perisher Skitube terminal.

WINTER WARNING No luggage is carried on Skitube during peak periods.

The Winter months bring a complete cover of snow to the Valley.

A Ski School operates 400 metres downhill from the Lodge.

Accommodation

The Lodge has nine bedrooms: 2 with 4 beds, 1 with 3 beds & 6 with 2 beds. Each has its own shower, basin & heater. The Lodge has an open fire & Billiard Table to provide for different styles of relaxation. The Loft area has a lounge and armchair far from the madding crowd which takes advantage of the spectacular view.

Bedding

Each bed has a doona, one Vellux velour blanket, and a pillow. Sheets & a pillowslip must be used. A number of woollen blankets are also available – look in bedrooms.

In **Winter** sheets, doona covers, pillowslips, bath towels & tea towels are supplied.

In **Summer** you MUST bring your own sheets, pillowslips, towels AND Tea Towels.

Bedroom Allocation

The allocation of beds is done in Sydney & advised by email to residents of each week. Due to the configuration of the Lodge this can be a tricky exercise. It is done sensitively & with consideration given to past accommodation & to grouping preference indicated on the Booking Form.

Note that the tariff is for a bed, a room cannot be assured.

As communal lodge, we ask that members and guests respect the privacy and quiet enjoyment of each resident in their allocated room.

Changeover Day

The Accommodation Week is from 10:00 am Sunday to Sunday.

Weekend accommodation is from after dinner Friday night to Sunday.

All other periods are charged at the Daily Rate.

Lodge Captain

The Lodge Captain is a volunteer, is also on holidays, is appointed for the week & is charged with the responsibility for the smooth running of the Lodge. Please assist your Captain by being proactive in doing those little things that will help in making it a holiday for all.

Dress Code

Smart casual clothing and suitable footwear are to be worn by all inside the Lodge.

Lodge Duties

Ku-ring-gai is a Club Lodge for the use of Members & their accompanied guests. As a condition of accommodation Residents are required to keep their rooms clean & tidy & to carry out the Lodge Daily Duties allocated to them by the Lodge Captain.

Precautions - Fire

Fire is an ever-present concern in the snowfields, the Lodge is constructed substantially of wood & the very low humidity means that it is tinder dry. A fire would raze the Lodge in 20 minutes.

It is IMPERATIVE that on your arrival you find & note the location of all fire extinguishers, fire hoses & exit routes.

Exercise caution when using the Slow Combustion Fire in the living room. If leaving unattended for any period ensure that the door is closed.

SMOKING is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN inside the Lodge.

Precautions – Snow and Ice Build up

Exercise caution when walking into Lodge entrances, under eaves and around balconies as in certain conditions ice and snow can build up on the roof and from time to time this will fall and may cause injury.

Cooking

Residents cook for themselves & often arrange to team up with others to cook in a group. A gas barbeque is on the verandah.

Food Store

The Tariff includes free access to a basic food store for residents without additional charge. It includes tea, coffee (instant & fresh), breakfast foods, biscuits, jams, basic cooking requirements & condiments. Guests must provide their own perishable foodstuffs.

During WINTER only, a well-stocked Supermarket is located in the Skitube Terminal. On departure, food brought to the Lodge and not consumed must be taken home or thrown out.

DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING.

Liquor

The Supermarket on the Skitube Concourse has a good range at sensible prices (Winter only).

Toilets

Please observe the notice regarding foreign matter being placed in toilets.

Laundry & Drying Rooms

The Drying Room is very efficient for drying both damp & wet ski gear. Please remove clothes and boots when dry – DO NOT USE AS A WARDROBE.

A Washing Machine, Clothes Dryer & Sink are located on the Bottom Level.

Boots, Skis & Boards

Should be left in one of the two Ski Rooms. Wet ski boots should not be worn inside the Lodge.

Visitors

Your friends are welcome in the Lodge.

Should they stay for a meal & utilise the Food Store please pay the Lodge Captain \$2 each.

Telephone

All out-going calls MUST be recorded - Time of day, destination, length & cost calculation.

Pay the Lodge Captain before leaving.

Vacating Lodge

Complete your allocated Lodge Duties, clean & vacate your room with your luggage.

To be done BEFORE 10:00 am on your day of departure.

Winter Booking - Priority & Allocation

Member's Preferential Bookings are allocated on 1st May. All applications rank equally at this date.

The following priority applies:

1. Members
 2. Guests accompanied by members.
- Large Parties accompanying members are discouraged.
 - Children Under 5 - Winter Bookings - please restrict to designated Toddler's Weeks.

Cancellation Fee if made 21 days prior to start of accommodation - \$50

Cancellation Fee if made within 21 days of accommodation start - 50% of tariff.
